

Water Trail Steward Job Description

Sound Rivers Mission: To monitor and protect the Neuse and Tar-Pamlico River watersheds covering nearly one quarter of North Carolina, and to preserve the health and beauty of the river basin through environmental justice.

Position Overview: The Water Trail Steward is responsible for managing and completing monthly inspections and required maintenance of at least 1 camping platform. The steward reports directly to the Water Trail Steward Manager (WTSM). This is a volunteer position.

Time Requirement: The position requires approximately 10-20 hours per month, depending on maintenance needs.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Perform monthly inspections of your assigned platform
- Maintain your platform for use of overnight campers
- Identify material or tool needs and report to WTSM
- Aid in maintenance of nearby platforms when necessary and/or available
- Complete monthly reports, with photos, for your platform and submit to WTSM
- Assist with material delivery and construction on new platform construction
- Track hours contributed to the water trail and submit to WTSM

Qualifications:

- Experience with general woodworking and maintenance tasks
- Ability to paddle or use a motorized boat
- Valid Driver's License
- Ability to work outside in wooded areas
- Ability to work with others
- Commitment to Sound Rivers' mission
